NZFC Doubles Fencing Competition at SIAFD Thursday 30th March 2017

Note: all Goldpine posts & strainers pre driven due to ground not suitable for borers.

- A judges/ demo fence will be erected and discussed at the judges briefing.
- The Judges briefing is a time to ask questions. Questions cannot be asked once competition has started.

DESCRIPTION:

Competitors must erect a 41 metre fence line consisting of a single fence with two product types

1. At one end 23 metres Goldpine roundwood product, consisting of

5 wires- top, third and bottom to be electric, tensioned to 100 kg 2nd and 4th wire down non electric tensioned to 150 kgs

1 x box assembly (strainers predriven)

At changeover point (approx 25 metre mark- midway between last Goldpine Superpost and first Waratah Joi Star) end insulator on top, third and bottom wire.

Insulators at this changeover point need to be vertical

2. Other end Waratah product consisting of 18 metres (Waratah product will be installed by competitors)

5 wires non electric onto Joi Star® standard Waratah posts with wires connected through Jio Clips®

1 x end assembly using Warath Ezi Pipe system

- 3. Hang 1 x 3.66 m pipe gate + latch to latch post (hand dig latch post)
- 4. Independent Strainrite irrigator crossing

OVERALL HEIGHTS & SPACINGS OF DRIVEN POSTS:

Box Stayed Strainer - 1175mm

Posts - 1175 mm

Post Spacings netting - 5 metres

Post Spacings irrigator crossing 10 metres

WARATAH PRODUCT

- Competitors need to install.
- Competitors will need a standard Waratah or Y post driver and a cordless drill, 8 inch crescent
- Waratah will provide a Driver for the Ezi pipe end assembly and a Drill bit.
- Note The Ezi Pipe end assemblies will not be pinned.

SPECIFICATIONS:

1. Wire spacing's from top

65mm

340mm

580mm

775mm

985mm

- 2. Goldpine Horizontal end assembly, stay to be squared and morticed both ends and positioned between the top two wires. Diagonal tie wire will be 3 times 2.5mm wire.
- 3. Wire tension 100 kg on electric wires and 150 kg on non electric wires

 Test wire supplied to calibrate tension gauges

Pivot Crossing Fence Specs – all Strainrite Product

2 x 2.5mm HT wires 600mm & 900mm off ground End posts top height of 1m

- 2 Sureflex Spring kit at one end (kit includes Spring, end insulator, perm wire strainer & two line clamps)
- 2 Underground cable lengths feeding from spring line clamps back to end post
- 2 High strain end insulators at other end of strain
- 1 Electric fence Warning sign on top wire near End Insulator.
- 2 20mm x 1200mm polypipe sleeves threaded on wires to centre of gap (cable holes pre-drilled)
- 2 600mm Y post tie-down pegs driven level with ground, in line with polypipe ends
- 2 4mm wire "U" staples threaded through top hole of each tie down peg
- 2 1.8m Bayco wire tie-down cables (each one doubled)
- 10 5mm crimp sleeves for securing Bayco cable each side of polypipes and attaching to peg staple.

Springs pre-loaded to 2mm gap between windings.

RULES:

- 1. Competitors must supply their own tools unless stated.
- 2. Competitors must not infringe on other lines.
- 3. Safety footwear must be worn.
- 4. No drop starting of chainsaws and only trained competent operators to use.
- 5. Chainsaw chaps and safety glasses must be worn while chain sawing.
- 6. Eye protection/safety glasses to be used during ALL wire work.
- 7. Ear protection while using motorised equipment.
- 8. No material will be prepared before competition.
- 9. Only supplied materials can be used on fence line
- 10.21m.m bit for Lock Thru Gudgeon.
- 11. Posts are pre driven and competitors are to check the post height prior to competition start
- 12.time point penalty 1 per minute after first team has finished and called time

Judging includes safety penalties for unsafe practices. If the practice is observed beyond a one off occurrence a verbal warning and correction advice to the competitor will be issued by the judges and full safety penalties will be awarded on doing so.

There will be Judges demo fence erected which you can use pre competition for reference.

GENERAL:

- A barbeque will be held for competitors while judging is taking place
- You can talk through your lines with the Judges after judging
- We have organized well known rural sports commentator Craig Wiggins as our MC, we have a PA system, please ensure you fill out your info forms page 6 and have them returned so Craig can say nice things about you and promote your business.
